


Climate Monitoring Summit
October 19-20, 2010
ESSIC, 5825 University Research Court, College Park, MD

The Climate Monitoring Summit (CMS) will be held October 19-20, 2010, in College Park, Maryland. The CMS is jointly hosted by the Climate Prediction Center (CPC) of NOAA and the Earth System Science Interdisciplinary Center (ESSIC) of the University of Maryland. The meeting will be at ESSIC, located in the M-Square research park about two miles from the main College Park campus. The site is accessible by car and mass transit. Parking is free at the M-Square building where the meeting will be held. The cost of lunch for both days and for refreshments at breaks will be covered by a \$30.00 fee. We ask that attendees choose lunches from the choices given below before they arrive.

The M-Square building is at 5825 University Research Court, College Park, MD. The address is shown on Google Maps, although Google may say the city is Riverdale. A map showing the building location relative to the main College Park campus is included below. The meeting will be on the 4th floor of the building. The ESSIC conference room has a projector that speakers may load documents onto using a flash drive. The projector is windows based, so if speakers produce documents on a mac they may want to convert them to windows-based or to pdf documents.

There is complimentary morning and afternoon shuttle service from the College Park metro station. 

Lunch Ordering


Organic field greens, grapes, marinated chicken breast, feta, nuts, dried cranberries, pumpkin seeds, organic apples and raisins.
